Done by a Slough Company. Self certification done by patient then this is referred to the company in Slough who assess patients. In rare circumstances, the Slough company will contact GP for information for which a fee is payable.

Enhanced Services

- ❖ Thame Hospital still under contention. Vale of Aylesbury recognises this need to be contestable.
