Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes were accepted.

Additional Payments

More detailed version of Berks papers proposed.

Action Point: To be discussed further at Oxford County LMC. PHR to feed back to CT.

PCT Management Proposal

LMC keen to support the proposal.

Premises

Premises has stagnated across the Thames Valley. CT said £125, 000 had been spent on improvements for central allocations. LMC challenging PCTs who agreed with StHa to hold back £1.7 million.

Action Point: PCT to write to all practices to clarify position on premises finance.

OOHs

Call handling problem was discussed. Practices not being notified. PCT talked with Ambulance Trust about this.

Action Point: PCT to report back.

Verbal agreement that Ambulance Trust to continue call handling for 2 months. LMC want 3 months of change notice.

Knee & Hip Services

PCT has informed all practice managers that they no longer have to use NZ scoring.

PCB/Choose & Book

3 workshops have taken place. PBC can only work with practices on board. PCT asked how LMC fits in? LMC said the difficulty was the link with choose & book. LMC said they would not persuade GPs to join until there was greater clarity.

Enhanced Services

Services to be under spent by £160,719.00 to the floor but the proposed spend was greater than the floor and the floor should be £387,079.00.

GPs were underpaid for taking on certain services and should be paid the full amount. PB said he felt strongly that GPs had not been sufficiently recompensed for providing services on the cheap.

Action Point: PCT to consider that any excess amount should be paid on a per capita basis. PR to see the rules on roll over.

Dermatology GPSI included in the enhanced services floor was disputed. LMC told PCT that they are in dispute and PCT should notify the StHa. PCT wanted further discussion.

The enhanced services spec was discussed. Minor injuries agreed to be a LES.

Action Point: PCT to contact practices to discuss options.

IUCD. – LMC said the pricing was wrong and needed uplifting.

Palliative care – PCT does not wish to uplift the 03/04 prices.

Heart Failure – LMC asked if there was an issue of decommissioning services. PCT said there had been a large increase in secondary care.

Basket – Uplift on prices was questioned. LMC proposed that Zoladex should be a LES. LMC preference to shrink the list and have LES for specific items.

Action Point: PHR to send Zoladex LESs to CT.

Intra-Partum check in blue book, £50 per episode.

Drugs & Alcohol Abuse - Prices not uplifted.
